### SECURITY TIPS

1. Never give your Personal Identification Number (PIN) to anyone.
2. Never write the PIN on the card or keep the PIN in the same place as the card.
3. When shopping over the internet, ensure you are visiting a secure website before typing your card information. A secure website will have the following:
  - a. A picture of a padlock in the lower right hand corner of the screen; or
  - b. A website address that begins with "https:" The "s" means the site is secure.
4. Shred receipts if the entire card number is printed on the receipt.
5. Check bank statements regularly to ensure no one has compromised the card number.
